# THE PROPHECY OF MICAH -- 3 Prophecy Cycles of <u>Judgment</u> and <u>Mercy</u>

**The Setting:** The people of Israel are in rebellion and have sinned against God.

1<sup>st</sup> Cycle: Destruction and Regathering

Micah chapters 1 & 2 ment (1:2-16)

-- The <u>Revelation</u> of coming judgment (1:2-16) -- The <u>Reasons</u> for coming judgment (2:1-11)

-- The <u>Regathering</u> after judgment (2:12-13) The Good Shepherd

2<sup>nd</sup> Cycle: Doom and Deliverance

Micah chapters 3,4 & 5

Doom for leaders, false prophets, Jerusalem (3:1-12)
 Deliverance through the coming kingdom (4:1-:5:1)
 The Deliverer (His first coming 5:2-3 and His second coming 5:4-15)

3<sup>rd</sup> Cycle: Denunciations and Salvation

Micah chapters 6 & 7

-- God's <u>indictments</u> (6:1-5 and 6:9-16) -- Israel's <u>replies</u> (6:6-8 and 7:1-10)

-- God's Exaltation and Salvation of His people (7:11-20)

**NOTICE:** In every cycle <u>GOD'S MERCY PREVAILS</u> through and over His judgment of His true people.

# CHAPTER 2 The REASONS for the COMING JUDGMENT

- Woe to those who devise wickedness and work evil on their beds! When the morning dawns, they perform it, because it is in the power of their hand.
- 2 They covet fields and seize them, and houses, and take them away; they oppress a man and his house, a man and his inheritance.
- 3 Therefore thus says the LORD: behold, against this family I am devising disaster, from which you cannot remove your necks, and you shall not walk haughtily, for it will be a time of disaster.
- 4 In that day they shall take up a taunt song against you and moan bitterly,

and say, "We are utterly ruined;

he changes the portion of my people;

how he removes it from me!

To an apostate he allots our fields."

**5** Therefore you will have none to cast the line by lot in the **assembly** of the LORD.

#### **KEY OBSERVATIONS:**

Isaiah blasts <u>corrupt politics</u> in the capital, Micah blasts the <u>social wrongs</u> in his province.

In the Minor Prophets we see God's hatred of social injustice and crime.

Many Mosaic laws were designed to protect the <u>poor</u> and <u>powerless</u>.

Here we see <u>law twisting</u> resulting in **land grabbing** oppression of the <u>weak</u>.

- it is premeditated vs 1
- it is brazen and shameless vs 1
- it is ruthless and merciless vs 2
- it is <u>illegal</u> vs 2 Lev. 25; Num 27; 1Kng 21

God will judge the whole nation of Israel by sending the godless Assyrians and Babylonians to crush and humble them. vs 3-4

A remnant will remain. vs 5

- 6 "Do not preach"—thus they preach— "one should not preach of such things; disgrace will not overtake us."
- 7 Should this be said, O house of Jacob? Has the LORD grown impatient? Are these his deeds?

Do not my words do good to him who walks uprightly?

- 8 But lately my people have risen up as an enemy; you strip the rich robe from those who pass by trustingly with no thought of war.
- 9 The women of my people you drive out from their delightful houses; from their young children you take away my splendor forever.
- 10 Arise and go,

for this is no place to rest, because of uncleanness that destroys with a grievous destruction.

- 11 If a man should go about and utter wind and lies, saying, "I will preach to you of wine and strong drink," he would be the preacher for this people!
- 12 I will surely assemble all of you, O Jacob;
  I will gather the remnant of Israel;
  I will set them together
  like sheep in a fold,
  like a flock in its pasture,
  a noisy multitude of men.
- 13 He who opens the breach goes up before them; they break through and pass the gate, going out by it.
  Their king passes on before them, the LORD at their head.

# **NINE KEY APPLICATIONS:**

- 1) Just because you don't see <u>judgment coming</u> doesn't mean that it isn't.
- 2) Just because certain people may seem insignificant to you doesn't mean they are insignificant God.
- 3) How you treat 'insignificant people' will directly affect how God treats you.
- 4) Just because you <u>can</u>, doesn't mean you <u>should</u>.
- 5) Just because something is legal doesn't mean that it is right.
- 6) Just because something is illegal doesn't mean that it is wrong.
- 7) Only God is the <u>arbiter</u> of right and wrong. Not you, not anyone else.
- 8) False preachers are <u>everywhere</u>. Be very, very careful.
- 9) Remaining in repentance and faith in Jesus Christ is the only way to rest & blessing.

#### **KEY OBSERVATIONS:**

**Vs. 6-7** Wicked, <u>lying preachers</u> have always existed!

- They minimize sin and judgment. vs 6
- They cater to selfish desires.
- They utter <u>nonsense</u> and <u>lies</u>. vs 11
- They are like drunkards.

## Vs. 8 & 9 expands vs. 2

- Like an enemy within!
- treacherous highway robbers
- destroy the sweetly vulnerable
- ravage the innocent, joyful, trusting

Vs 10 GET OUT! Off to exile you go.

- your disgusting disease of sin
- think 'flesh-destroying leprosy '

Vs 11 (above) Lying, foolish preachers

#### Vs 12 & 13

All of the remnant will be gathered.

- The Good Shepherd will bring them in.
- The Savior-King leads them out.
